Status Of Skill Training In India

India is currently facing a huge socio - demographic challenge given that majority of its population is in the working age with limited or no skill. As per the labour Bureau Report 2014, the size of the skilled workforce in India is only 2%. Which is extremely low when compared to countries such as China 47%, Japan 80% and south Korea 96%. It is estimated that by around 2025, 25% of the world's total workforce will be in India's population would be 29 in 2013as compared to China's average age of 37 thus giving India a unique advantage of having one of the World's youngest population. However, a large young population alone does not guarantee India an advantage. The Country needs to ensure that its young workforce is equipped withthe skill and knowledge required in a workforce so it can reap the demographic dividend. To bring about a focus on skilling and consolidate efforts, the central government has brought all the king skilling programme under the ambit of a ministry created in 2014 the ministry of skill development and entrepreneurship. The government has further stepped up its efforts through the announcement of two skill development packages worth Rs. 220 Billion in July to improve the skill of 15 million people by 2020.

The NSSO employment Survey Reports have shown low unemployment rates in India. However, these survey also show that while many people are doing more than one job at a time, a lot many may be underemployed as they are in look out for a better job. If we categorize theme under disguised unemployment and add their numbers to completely unemployed, then the magnitude to the problem is properly appreciated.

Skills and knowledge are the driving forces of economic growth and social development of any country.



EDUCATION

Education is a path to building equal opportunities. The Foundation has been providing academic support to the government by way of curriculum development, pedagogy and has created self-directed learning materials to elevate the standard of education. The Foundation has rooted its programs in government schools to provide amenities which are otherwise restricted to private schools.

Being educated or literate leads to greater self-confidence and self-esteem. It enables engagement with development processes and Trust's of governance from a position of strength. Poor women from socially disadvantaged communities are invariably not literate and therefore find themselves at a disadvantage when participating in development processes. They are unable to take full advantage of progressive measures like reservations in PRIs. Many of the negative fall-outs of being outside the education net for women are quite recognized, however, the articulation of the problem tends to remain at the level of rhetoric. The Comprehensive project encompasses the creation of instructional design, training of teachers and teacher educators, regular mentoring support to teachers, provision of teaching-learning material, and regular impact assessment.

We are having our own E-Learning Technical Platforms to skill the trainees and beneficiaries.

Health Checkup Camps:

Health of rural poor men, women & children being checked up medicines are being distributed with the help of local P.H.C. doctor, during post cyclone period the health camp was organized in Villages of District SHEOHAR in (BIHAR). PHC, NCR & small family norm has been regularly discussed monthly SHG meetings.

Health and Well being: Equitable, universal access to health for all, including prevention of communicable and non- communicable diseases, malnutrition, maternal, child and reproductive health as well as healthy habit formation. Access to potable water, sanitation and hygiene. Both in urban and rural areas, Biocon Foundation invests in health and well-being at all stages of the life, that leads to enhanced opportunities to lead a high-quality life for all.

Malaria Eradication Programme:

"AKSHAT INTERNATIONAL TRUST" has organized a two days camp for the rural people where malaria is more acute. About 200 male and female attended the camp & took part in the discussion. Two paramedical workers facilitated in the camp and made aware the people that malaria is being prevented if proper care has been taken during sleeping by using mosquito net and keeping clean their living surroundings. The people were also motivated that they should obey this suggestion.

Livelihood And Skill Development

AKSHAT INTERNATIONAL TRUST is working in various ways to enable local communities to learnnew skills and improve incomes. This includes supporting self-help groups under the National Rural Livelihood Mission, youth skill and entrepreneurial development, and more inclusive and effective implementation of the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS).

Earning with Dignity: Employee ability and skill development, job placement, small scale entrepreneur assistance leading to sustainable livelihood opportunities that create strong and self-reliant people and communities.

Targeted at youth and women in urban and rural areas, Biocon Foundation's comprehensive programme train them in a variety of vocational and entrepreneurial subjects, that lead to dignified work opportunities.

Agriculture (Krishi):

Biocon is helping farmers learn new techniques that help reduce cost of cultivation, improve production quality and quantity, and raise income levels through agricultural extension, crop diversification, improvement of practice in traditional crops, promotion of community Societies like farmer's clubs. placed emphasis on women and under privileged families. During thereporting period, training on Typing, short hand, Embroidery Tailoring etc. was provided in two phases. All the beneficiaries belong to SC and ST families of SHEOHAR dist. Village. trained up making and bottling. Total 25 women were provided training and three SHGs have been formed among the beneficiaries for easy marketing.

Project Summary

The project is in line with government effort to establish as many pre - schools, primary schools and secondary schools as possible so that many children get access to education. Quality basic education is very important to even the poor children. People of SHEOHAR, (BIHAR), constitutes empowerment; and it is one of the tools that will empower the country in different aspects of the war against poverty.

Priority Need

The priority need of this project proposal is to have an education Trust which will join hand with the ministry of education's effort of having a nation with high level of education at all levels; a nation which produces the quality and quantity of educated people sufficiently equipped with the requisite knowledge to solve the Trust's problems in order to meet the challenges of development and attain competitivenessat regional and global at large at affordable costs.

Project Objectives

This project proposal has two main objectives as mentioned here under:

To respond to the needs of a rapidly growing business and education sector in SHEOHAR, (BIHAR) by producing the quality and quantity of educated people sufficiently equipped with the requisite knowledge to solve the Trust's problems in order to meet the challenges of development and attain competitiveness at regional and global at large at affordable costs.

The following objectives will be implemented after getting approval from the Ministry of Education and Vocational Training.

The School will provide subsidized healthy meals daily to children attending this Centre School. This Centre will continue to raise funds for running the operation of the school by requesting sponsorship for educating the children attending this centre.

The supporting administrative and ancillary staff who will facilitate the operation of the school.

Parents and guardians in the community who are interested in giving their children the opportunity of education at this education centre.

Project Results

This project is planned to be constructed at a minimum low cost so as to enable BIOCON FOUNDATION, (20th KM Hosur Road, Electronic City, Bangalore 560100) afford to pay the required fees. Construction will be conducted in three phases as follows: Phase one will start in year one, focusing on construction of pre - primary school and other necessary planned buildings. Phase two will follow year two for aiming for construction of primary school class rooms with other necessary planned buildings and phase three will start year four for construction of secondary school class rooms.

Objective of the Project

Project approach

Goals: The project goal is mainly for the construction of buildings for the pre -school, primary school and secondary school for the purpose of providing education. The buildings will cater for learning and boarding requirement of all pupils and students; plus the accommodation requirements of the teachers other school staff. The students and pupils physical fitness requirements will be met by having a sports arena in the school and grounds.

Objective and output: The main objective is to respond to the needs of a rapidly growing business and education sector in SHEOHAR, (BIHAR) by producing the quality and quantity of educated people sufficiently equipped with the requisite knowledge to solve the Trust's problems in order to meet the challenges of development and attain competitiveness at regional and global at large at affordable costs. This will be met by having **AKSHAT INTERNATIONAL TRUST** Centre in place.



Promoting Education & Sanitation:

In line with the "Serva Shiksha Abhiyan" and "Swaccha Bharat Campaign" of the Government of India, we have initiated a CSR Project "Promoting Education by Creating Sanitation & Drinking Water Facility at Government Schools" under which we are making our sincere efforts to provide a better overall EDUCATION environment to approx. 800 Underprivileged school children who are pursuing their EDUCATION dreams in Government school at & Villages of District- SHEOHAR in (BIHAR) initially, we have adopted total **20** Government Primary and higher primary schools in the first phase.

We are committed to provide following types of facilities to modernize these schools with and allocated budget of approx. INR. 27,50,000.00

- Construction of Separate Toilet, Blocks For Boys & Girls.
- Construction and Repair of overall existing infrastructure i.e School Building. Boundary walls, Class Rooms, Floors, Kitchens, Play Ground and Electrical Fittings,
- ❖ Complete White Wash of the school building as well as paintings of all doors & windows.
- ❖ Installation of Submersible under 200 feet of Ground for un-interrupted supply of good Qualitydrinking water within the school premise.
- Separate Drinking Water & Hand Wash Stations, a place within the school itself where students can drinking water and clean their hands before having their mid-day-meal.
- ❖ Distribution of Fans, School Kits, Dental Kits and Utensils for Mid-day-meal.
- Construction of mid-day-meal area covered by Tin-shed along with development & Maintenance and sustainability under this Program.
- ❖ We have been Distributing note book to the needy children of low end- school for the past 2 years. We are Continuously increasing the number of beneficiary students. In the Current Financial year (2020-21) we plan to distributed furniture, Computer Dresses to under Privileged Students in nearby primary schools. During winter we distribute woolen cloths to the students in association with local Non- Government Organization.
- ❖ Safe drinking water is a major area of concern especially in villages. We have already installed hand pumps in many villages and will continue to do the same as per the requirement of local villages.

- b) Becoming aware of the causes of their deprivation and moving towards amelioration of their condition through implementing Trust and participation in the process of development.

- d) Imbibing the values of national integration, conservation of the environment, women's equality, observance of small family norms.
- e) To prevent migration of the rural occupations are not as regarding as those in the urban areas.
- f) To create new skills among rural poor candidates entrepreneurs to learn modern techniques/methods in training and entrepreneurship skill.
- g) The Foundation has dug borewells and constructed overhead Water tanks in several villages to provide safe drinking water to the villagers.

BIOCON FOUNDATION has been contributing to the Student's community for more than five decades directly and indirectly. We have Schools where rural students can access premium education at minimal or no fees. Plus, We offer Scholarship for Meritorious Students.

Target Group:

The target group to be covered under the proposed Program includes marginalized assets less rural poor women and the urban poor. This includes wage laborers unpaid daily workers, female headed household's migrant laborers tribal and other dispossessed groups with special focus on poor and needy candidates. The children who currently attend normal Kinder garden, Primary School and Secondary school, as well as the children living in SHEOHAR, (BIHAR) community who need to improve their education level, The teachers who instruct the children according to the Syllabus provided by the Ministry of Education and Vocational Training; The supporting administrative and ancillary staff who will facilitate the operation of the school. Parents and guardians in the SHEOHAR, (BIHAR) community who are interested in giving their children the opportunity of education at this education center. It has been decided by management committee that for this training only youth of poor class families shall be taken however care shall be taken that they must be hard working honest and obedient.

In shall also be cared that candidate must belong to the age group of 18-35 years and must be literate up to metric.

- 1. Leverage a local resource (either an individual or body) with similar experiences as the potential trainees to earn their empathy and.
- 2. The local resource should ideally have access to a wide network within the community or target group.
- 3. Engage a variety of strategies, always based on relevance to target group, such as:
 - Setting up career counselling centre in slum areas/villages.
 - Engaging key stakeholder and parents through cluster meeting and mediums such as street plays.
 - Conducting enrolment drives through local educational institutes, industry associations, dealership, etc.
 - Organizing job melas through the block or district development offices.
 - Using alumni of the programme as role models and establishing a referral system.
 - Distributing leaflets and pamphlets in the community.
 - Going door to door to mobilize people.

Need of this Program

Unemployment is biggest problem in our country. Thousands of candidates are idle in absence of proper employment this time it is very essential that these candidate should be provided training in such trade which should be easy to learn and should be job oriented. For this purpose in training of above trades is very suitable because this trade is suitable to average mind of candidates. Since rural areas of Dist.-SHEOHAR, (BIHAR) is places where people of several castes therefore here demand always stand. Therefore, such training shall be very beneficiaries for trainees. In-fact that Dist.-SHEOHAR, (BIHAR). Computer Training is known for all trainees, always run-in shortage, therefore such trainee has very good job opportunities.

Implementation Strategy:

Management Committee feels that no project can run smoothly unless its implementing process is up to mark, in order to provide a proper Shape the whole activities have been divided into the following.

SELECTION OF INSTRUCTORS:-

It is true that any project cannot run without the skilled & intelligent instructors and other staff, in fact they are the backbone for running any project. Successes of any project to a very large extent depend upon the selection of instructions & other staff. For this purpose care shall be taken that instructors must be knowledgeable, hardworking and well behaved person. They must be at least diploma holders in this trade. Advertisement shall be given in newspaper for wider choice.

SELECTION OF CANDIDATES:-

For this Project care shall be taken that trainees must have some basic education and they must belong to poor class families. However selection of candidates shall be made on the basis of individual meeting of candidates. If there will be any policy of Department regarding the selection of candidates the same shall be followed in to.

SELECTION PROCESS:-

The Instructors and other staffs staff shall be appointed by constituting a board of management that shall consist of four members. The decision of board of management shall be final and binding up on both the parties. The board of management shall consist of following members:-

- Representative of District Authority.
- Representative of funding Agency.
- One Technical Expert.
- Representative of Trust.

PROBLEM TO BE TACKLED:

Duet to many government and non-government and reputed companies nearby cities intervention, the employment facilities are well above average standard and the facilities available for poor and needy candidates for income generation through the regular training are negligible and whereas unfortunately, there are no such facilities to promote technical training like training, Computer training to the poor candidates in free of cost. Hence, this Trust forces them for losing of employment opportunity in different sectors. As result of which so many candidates of the proposed project areas still unemployed having no earning facilities after campaigning the higher income generation. So this project will create employment opportunities to those poor candidates.

FEASIBILITY OF PROJECT:-

The selected project areas is a backward in self-employment. The changing Scenario of the Technology in the District and the low-level employment with the migrant of professionals had needed us to setting-up the training center.

Computer training requires dedicated efforts combined with patience and accuracy. Candidates are idealistic in nature for such jobs. I he needs to training and trained candidates for the rural Technology industries arise from the fact that shortage of professionals matching up to an ever-increasing demand and the levels is alarming rural Technology has come up in every wild of life and become an integral part of modern Trust. The candidate trained under the scheme is employed at various positions available in different Govt. and Non Govt. agencies, industries within and outside the district.

PROJECT MANAGEMENT AND MONITORING:-

The project will be managed by AKSHAT INTERNATIONAL TRUST and will lead the group in providing high quality of training. This organization will be responsible to assess the performances of the candidates every month and to improve their skill regularly. There will be regular examination for the trainees and their opinion on various relevant matters will be obtained and taken into consideration for monitoring of the progress. Periodic progress report will be prepared and submitted to the funding agency that will consolidate the report and send to the funding agency.

The budget consists of initial non-recurring expenditure for the first year. The recurring expenses will be required for the subsequent year on the pattern of the first year. For accurate details of the entire budget items are seen in budget head.

STRATEGY OF TRAINING PROGRAM:-

PLACEMENT OF CANDIDATE AFTER TRAINING:-

The ultimate motto of each funding agency behind each Program financially supported by them is that its trainees should be well established to fulfill the purpose of project. If trainees are not properly placed its purpose shall be defeated.

In order to solve this problem it has been planned that after training this centre shall be converted into job center by giving a shape of co-operative Trust and these candidates shall be a member to this Trust. The function of this job center shall be to prepare the work as ordered by customers through Trust. In this way every trainee will get the employment and shall be able to earn good profit to pass their lives happily.

PROJECT SUSTAINABILITY:

Now a day's unemployment is biggest problem is our country a lot of number of youth are idle in absence of proper employment this time it is very essential that these youths & females should be provided training by formation of self-help Group ins such trade is very suitable. Because this trade is suitable to arrange mind of youth.

Depending on experience, the candidates can become self-sufficient start from Rs. 15,000/- to Rs. 25000/- immediate job available in the industries and marketing mentioned above Due to increasing values of the computer skilled candidates, absorbed hands can be requested to donate some of their remuneration which can be used as a "Revolving Found" for meeting the stipend and other basic maintenance expenditure of the center once the recurring funds from the project.

Major functions of Akshat International Trust:-

- 1. **Save birds save life :-** Under this, establishment of bird park in rural and urban areas. To arrange suitable environment and food and water for the birds, for its habitat, the organization constructs a reservoir on the barren and barren plots and plants trees around it so that the birds can create a favorable environment for their habitat.
- 2. **One Person One Tree Program:** Under this every person of the society is motivated to plant at least one tree in his name or in the name of his family members. Under this program more than 1500 trees have been planted so far.
- 3. **Akshar Gyan Daan Program:** Under this program, those children who have become disenchanted with school education due to any reason or have left school in between, counseling of their parents is done by identifying those children and re-nomination of that child. This is done in the nearest school. So far 963 children have been re-enrolled and linked to the school.
- 4. **Akshar Bal Vikas:-** Under this program, the opportunity of quality education is provided to the needy children at a minimum fee. Under this, the organization is providing facilities in agreement with Akshar International School in Shivhar district and NH International School in Pupri block of Sitamarhi.
- 5. **Akshat Nasha Mukti cum Rehabilitation Program:** Under this, various types of public awareness programs like seminars, bebinars and public relations are organized in which seriously drug addicts are identified and their treatment is done for Akshat Nasha Mukti cum rehabilitation. Center, Shivhar and Sitamarhi District's Pupri, Akshat Nasha Mukti Rehabilitation Center is admitted and treated, where proper arrangements have been made for free accommodation, food and treatment for the patient and one of his relatives. Yoga and spiritual education are given at the center so that the patient does not get trapped in this quagmire again.
- 6. **Beti Padhao Beti Bachao:-** With this programme, arrangements have been made for free enrollment, education and training in schools for girls from weak and poor society.
- **Eligibility** To avail benefits under this, self-declaration affidavit of the parent is enough that he is unable to bear the education expenses of his girl child. Till then 35 girls have been provided education from nursery to class 10 under this programme, under which children are given training in dance, singing and self-defense.
- 7. **Akshat Arogya:-** Under this, free health camps, medical camps, counseling camps and health awareness camps are organized in rural areas through rural doctors, medical institutions. Under this, more than 25 camps have been organized so far and more than 2200 people have been benefitted.
- 8. **Akshat Distance Learning Program:-** Under this, through the distance education system of different types of universities, children are provided a platform to do various types of vocational and educational courses. From here, assistance is provided in completing the enrollment and teaching process in distance learning places sitting at home.
- 9. **Akshat Samadhan:-** Under this, consultations are given on burning social problems like eradication of corruption, eradication of unemployment, family discord. Rural unemployed youth farmers are trained in organic farming, bio-compost, making vermi and cow dung while training is given to produce and store food items in organic ways.


The district occupies an area of 443 square km and has a population of 656,916 (as of 2011). Sheohar is known for its greenery and cleanest. Cadamba and teak are the principle trees of this district. Nilgai or blue bull is the regional animal of this area.

Agriculture is main source of occupation. It is one of the most flood affected district in Bihar due to over flooding of the Bagmati and Budhi Gandak rivers. Devkuli is a holy place popular for ancient temple of lord Shiva. As of 2011 it is the second least populous district of Bihar (out of 39), after Sheikhpura.

It is bounded by three districts. Sitamarhi is in the north and east ,East Champaran is in the west and Muzaffarpur is in the south.

Sheohar district has only one sub-division named sheohar.

Transportation mode from this district is Road only.



INTRODUCTION OF ORGANIZATION

AKSHAT INTERNATIONAL TRUST

Introduction: Akshat International Trust has been formed under the Indian Trust Act 1882. Its headquarter is in Shivhar district of Bihar state. The founder of this trust is Mr. Sanjeev Kumar and the trustees are Mrs. Priyanka Singh and Mrs. Reena Devi. The trust is basically working in the field of education and health.

Trust's goal :- To provide basic facilities of education and health to the last person of the society, to ensure participation in social reform.

Goal:- To ensure the state's girl literacy rate is more than 90%. To create a drug-free, dowry-free, educated society. To provide employment and self-employment opportunities to the needy persons.

Most of the persons of target group are having minimal economic assets; therefore, provision of training and enhancing their competencies is essential for economic empowerment/ upliftment of these marginalized target groups. Many of the persons of target group belong to the category of rural artisans who have become marginalized owing to coming of better technologies in market. There is also a need to empower the women amongst the target group, who, due to their overall domestic compulsions, cannot be involved in wage employment which normally involves long working hours and sometimes migration to other cities. Similar challenges are faced by members of Sanitation Workers & Waste Pickers communities who find it difficult to get into mainstream alternate occupations and are forced to therefore engage in selfemployment activities. Similarly, the youth amongst the target group, owing to their educational backwardness also find it difficult to obtain employment with good compensation after undergoing shortterm skilling courses. On the other hand it is observed that the long term vocational courses being conducted by ITIs with better market prospects are having large number of vacancies in the SC and OBC categories. In view of the above, there is a dire need to go beyond routine skilling and instead enhance their competency levels so that artisans may improve on their revenue generation capacities within their practicing vocations, the women may enter into self-employment thereby financially empowering themselves without neglecting their domestic activities and the youth may acquire long-term training and specialization in employable vocations giving them better standing in the job market.

The Trust imparts vocational training to underprivileged women from surrounding villages in tailoring, embroidery, typing, beautician, English speaking, Tie & die, block printing and computer courses so that they can take up a vocation and earn a livelihood. Nearly 400 women/girls avail these facilities every year. Tailoring, typing, shorthand and computer courses are taught free of cost to the candidates who cannot pursue further studies.
